Measure C – 2007 Crime Fighting Act AND Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT)

MANDATORY Pre-Submission Applicant Orientation

The City of East Palo Alto will be accepting applications for eligible programs and projects under its Small Summer Grants Program, funded with Measure C and TOT funds. Both grants support projects and programs that utilize funds and relationships to provide a continuum of services that deliver measurable and impactful outcomes toward the goal of servicing youth, families, seniors, and re-entry citizens in the community of East Palo Alto. The Grant Program is competitive and encourages matching funds.

- **Measure C Small Grants Program:** For the purposes of this grant, small grant is defined as a program that focuses on violence prevention and impact YOUTH, or EX-FELONS (RE-ENTRY), or DOMESTIC VIOLENCE VICTIMS, and/or SENIORS in the East Palo Alto Community.

\$81,000.00 total available funding - individual request may not exceed \$22,500.00

- **TOT Small Summer Grants Program:** For the purposes of this grant, small summer grant is defined as a program ran strictly during the summer months that impact YOUTH, or FAMILIES, and/or SENIORS in the East Palo Alto community.

\$150,000.00 total available funding - individual request may not exceed \$16,000.00

Interested applicants **MUST** attend **ONE** of **TWO** orientation times. Only one organizational representative is required to attend. Orientations will be held on:

You will need to attend one of the orientations in order to receive an application. **Applications are due ELECTRONICALLY by Friday, April 21, 2017 at 5:00 p.m.** Awards are expected to be announced in Late May/Early June.
